

Chase the Ace

Inclusion Regina Rules:

1. \$5 per ticket
2. Draws are every Thursday at 7pm at Inclusion Regina office located at 2216 Smith Street, Regina SK. Commencing date of Thursday February 1st, 2018. Concluding date of Thursday January 31st, 2019. No draws on March 29th, 2018 or December 27th, 2018.
3. Tickets may only be purchased and sold exclusively in Saskatchewan.
4. Tickets may be purchased by payment of cash, debit, Visa, or MasterCard. Visa, MasterCard, and Debit can be a form of payment for ticket purchases \$20 and more.
5. There is no limit on total tickets that may be purchased by an individual.
6. Total number of tickets available for sale are 50,000.
7. A new deck of standard 52 playing cards is used. The winning card is Ace of Spades. Losing cards are destroyed after each draw.
8. The lottery will continue with weekly draws until the earlier of 1) the Ace of Spades is drawn or 2) All the tickets are sold or 3) The license expires.
9. If the lottery licence expires or all tickets are sold during the game before the ace of spades is drawn, there will be a second draw directly following the regular weekly draw on the last Thursday of the game. The second draw winner will be awarded the jackpot. Only tickets sold this week will be eligible for the second draw.
10. Chase the Ace players must be 18 years of age and older.
11. Tickets for each round of play can be purchased at Inclusion Regina, 2216 Smith Street, Regina SK during regular office hours. Deadline to purchase tickets for the weekly draw is Thursday at 12:00 pm.
12. Of total weekly ticket sales, 20% is awarded to the winning ticket holder on the day of the event. 30% is retained for the jackpot prize, and 50% is awarded to Inclusion Regina.
13. A random ticket draw and cutting the deck will take place at Inclusion Regina located at 2216 Smith Street, Regina SK, every Thursday commencing at 7pm. The winning ticket will be randomly chosen by a Proxy appointed by Inclusion Regina.
14. The Proxy is a volunteer who is assigned by Inclusion Regina's Executive Director. The proxy appointed will be announced at each draw at 7pm before the event begins. The proxy cannot purchase tickets or play Chase the Ace.
15. If the Ace of Spades is drawn at the first weekly round, 50% of total ticket sales from the round will be awarded to the random ticket draw winner.
16. The draw winner is not required to be present to win the draw prize of 20%.
17. The draw winner will be announced verbally, as well as displayed visually to those in attendance.
18. The draw winner is awarded the chance to win the jackpot by cutting the deck of cards.
19. If the winner is unable to attend, the Proxy appointed, and on site at Inclusion Regina, will cut the deck on behalf of the winner.
20. Winners will be awarded their prize in the form of a cheque up to 3 weeks after the day of the draw.

21. Any persons who are not involved in set-up, cutting the deck, selling tickets, or drawing of tickets may play Chase the Ace.
